

FREE OFFICIAL GED PRACTICE TEST

Participating in the GED Practice Test is a good starting point for many people. The GED Practice Test is designed to evaluate the level of your academic skills as compared to the level required to pass the actual test. The structure of the GED Practice Test is exactly identical to the actual test with the exception that it consists of ½ of the number of questions and allowed ½ of the time. Like the actual test, the GED Practice Test consists of the five major academic areas of a typical high school curriculum.

Upon completion of the test, it will be scored and the results given to you. A passing score on the Practice Test will enable you to earn a “fee waiver” to cover the \$55.00 application fee for the actual test. This fee waiver is good for one test in the calendar year. See reverse side of this flyer for locations and dates for the practice tests.



FREE ON-LINE GED PRACTICE TEST

Cuyahoga County Public Library offers on its website a GED Practice Test that you can complete at one of the branches or on your home computer if you have a library card. Completion of the Practice Test can help you evaluate your academic skills as you prepare to take the Actual GED Test. **A passing score on the Practice Test can also earn you a “fee waiver” which will cover the \$55.00 test application fee.**

FOLLOW THESE STEPS

- ◆ Go to your nearest branch library and access the GED Practice Test on a computer by connecting to www.learningexpresslibrary.com on the internet.
- ◆ Upon reaching the site, log in with your user name and password or follow directions as a first time user. (Be sure to write down your user name and password for future visits to this site). **Choose a Subject** by scrolling down to the **GED section**. There are many review sessions listed here, so feel free to browse through them. When ready, **click on GED Practice Tests**.
- ◆ You will reach the **Available Products page** where you will see five different Practice Tests listed. If you click on a test name, you will see a brief description of that test. Click on **Practice Now!** next to your choice of tests to begin a test. Here you will see a history of the work you have done. Decide which test to work on, and click **Continue** next to it.
- ◆ After reading the page of instructions, click **Start**. Notice the timer and the buttons at the top of the test page. Try these buttons before you begin the test so that you know the function of each. When you have completed a test, hit **Score My Test**. Complete all 5 Practice Tests in this manner. **Have each test scored by the computer. Print out the score sheets.**
- ◆ Then go back to the **Choose a Subject page**. Scroll down to the **GED section** where you will click on the last choice listed, **GED Writing Practice**. Complete this writing test, also. When finished, have the computer score it and **print out the score sheet.**
- ◆ Bring a **picture ID** and the **6 score sheets** to any **Parma Schools GED Practice Test site** during one of the sessions listed on the back of this flyer. Your overall achievement on the Practice Test will be evaluated to determine whether it meets the score requirement to receive a fee waiver. If your results meet the fee waiver requirements, then **a fee waiver will be given to you along with a GED Test application.**
