TRYOUT INFORMATION

- ❖ All candidates will attend two clinic nights. The material taught will include a sideline cheer, a 1 minute dance routine, basic tumbling & jumps.
 - Clinic Day 1
 - Monday, May 23rd, 3:15 pm 5:00 pm.
 - o Clinic Day 2
 - Tuesday, May 24th, 3:15 pm 5:00 pm.
 - Tryout Day
 - Thursday, May 26th, 5:00 pm 7:00 pm.
- ❖ The sideline cheer and dance will be original material that none of the students will have access to before the clinic nights. We want all of the candidates to have the same opportunity to learn!
- ❖ Previous cheer experience for incoming 8th graders at GMS will not guarantee a spot on next year's squad. The judges are not aware of previous cheer experience and will be judging skills alone, therefore making it fair for each candidate.
- ❖ Each candidate must submit 1 Teacher evaluation. Please note, a very low teacher evaluation score may disqualify a candidate from making the squad regardless of her tryout score. Please give one teacher evaluation form to a teacher. Evaluations are to be emailed to Hudsona@parmacityschools.org by May 20, 2022 from the teacher. Please get them to your teacher right away so they have time to get them turned in.
- ❖ All clinic and tryout sessions are closed to the public. Only candidates, judges and coaches are allowed in the tryout area.

*All athletes will receive a letter at the end of tryouts stating whether they made the squad or not.

- Both forms (Parent Consent and Application Form) are due when you check in on Day 1 of clinics in order to participate in tryouts.
- Any tumbling must be done without a spotter.
- On tryout day, please wear a plain white t-shirt, black shorts, and tennis shoes/cheer shoes of your choice and hair off face with a bow.
- No jewelry of any kind and you must bring water.

CHEERLEADING DEMERIT SYSTEM 2022-2023

Points or demerits will be used as a disciplinary tool. When a cheerleader receives a demerit, he or she will be given a demerit sheet. It needs to be signed by the parent and cheerleader and returned at the next game/practice. Girls will not be permitted to practice unless it is signed. If you miss a game/practice for this reason, another demerit will be given.



5 Demerits = Benched until Coach Determination

9 Demerits = Dismissal from team.

2-point violations can be characterized as, but not limited to:

- a) Missed practice, game, or event with no notice (plus benched)
- b) Missed practice, game, or event with less than 24-hour notice (unexcused)
- c) Inappropriate actions while in uniform
- d) PDA in Uniform (major)
- e) Leaving without coach permission

1-point violations can be characterized as, but not limited to:

- a) Poor attitude (after initial warning)
- b) Conflict with Coach, Teammate, or Staff Member (major conflicts will be immediate dismissal)

.5-point violations can be characterized as, but not limited to:

- a) Missed practice, game, or event with more than 24-hour notice (excused)
- b) Missing attire (shoes, poms, bow, uniform)
- c) Inappropriate social media content
- d) Lack of teamwork/sportsmanship
- e) Unauthorized use of electronic devices
- f) Any referral
- g) PDA in Uniform (minor to include hug &hand holding)

IF A CHEERLEADER IS SUSPENDED FOR ANY REASON, FOR ANY AMOUNT OF TIME, THEY WILL BE DISMISSED FROM THE TEAM UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY ADMINISTRATION. A MEETING WITH COACH, PARENT, ATHLETE AND ADMINISTRATION MUST BE HELD BEFORE THE CHEERLEADER WILL BE PERMITTED TO RETURN.

EXCUSED ABSENCES will be given for the following:

- I. Illness where the cheerleader is running a fever or under doctors' orders to not participate. (If you are not in school the day of a practice or game, you do not participate in the practice or game.)
- II. Death in the family/ family funerals
- III. School sponsored trips or activities that the student will receive a grade for. These must be communicated to the coach in advance and approved.
- IV. Family vacations
