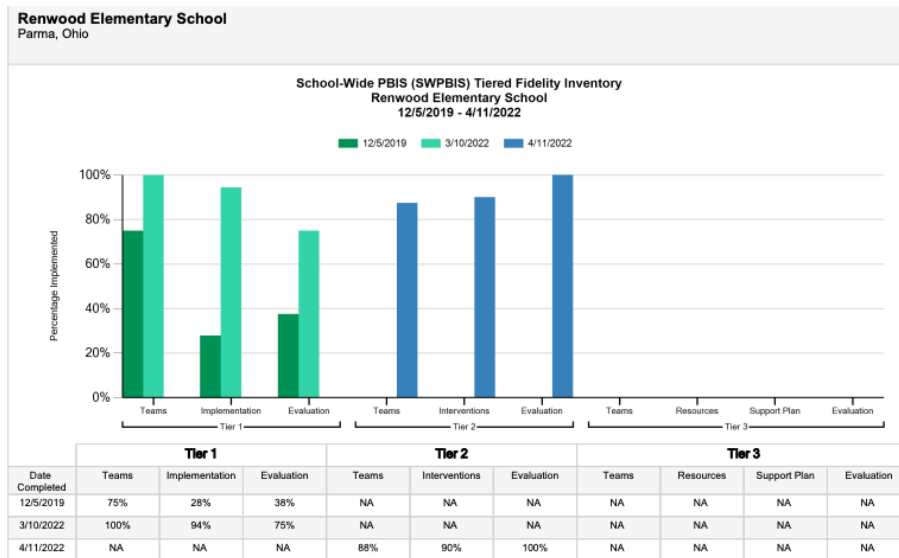


Renwood Elementary School

What is the status of PBIS implementation at Renwood Elementary?

Our school’s most recent TFI (a state-adopted PBIS assessment tool) indicates that Renwood is implementing both Tier 1 and Tier 2 PBIS with fidelity. The TFI indicates that we are implementing Tier 1 with fidelity at 90% and Tier 2 with fidelity at 92%. Within the 3 core features (Teams, Implementation, Evaluation), we are strong in all areas.



What is our Office Discipline Referral rate?

As of 3/30/2022, Renwood has recorded 42 minor referrals and 10 major referrals. When compared to data from 3/30/2021, Renwood had recorded 4 minor referrals and 1 major referral. ***As a disclaimer, the 2020-21 school year was during the COVID-19 pandemic. All of Parma City Schools, including Renwood, began the year with online learning. Students returned to campus from September 29-October 30, 2020, in a hybrid style. Only 1/3 of all students were on campus on any given day. Then from November 2, 2020,-January 14, 2021, all students were learning online again. From January 18-March 19, 2021, students returned to campus in a hybrid format. Then, from March 22-June 4, 2021, 2/3 of Renwood students were learning on campus in-person.**

How is our attendance?

2020-21 School Year: 94.67%

2021-22 School Year: 93.33%

We are working to continue to improve our attendance. The PBIS Team will look at this data in August, 2022, to decide if any research-based attendance initiatives need to be put into place to increase our attendance percentage. Thank you to the Renwood families for your help in getting your child(ren) to school every day!

How do students access Tier 2 interventions?

Families and staff members can complete a request for assistance indicating the student's need for additional support. Students are generally identified through major office discipline referrals, attendance issues, difficulty in school, and/or student referral. The Tier 2 team reviews the referrals biweekly and makes decisions about which Tier 2 intervention would best fit the student. Parent permission is required before any student begins a Tier 2 intervention.

How effective are our Tier 2 interventions?
