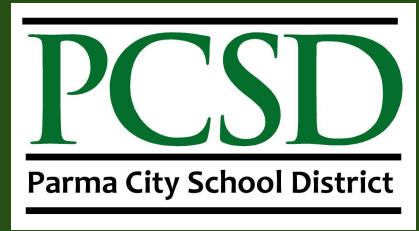

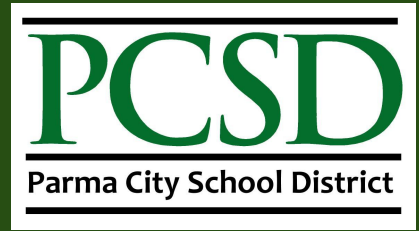

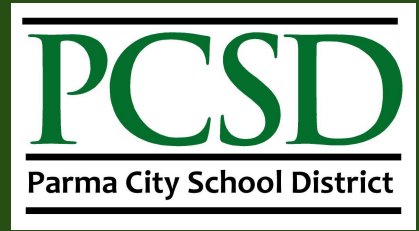
Funded by ESSER
