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### What is Title One?

Pleasant Valley is a Schoolwide Title One building. What does that mean? This means that the **entire** building qualifies for Title One services. This does not mean that your child will be seen by one of the Title teachers. In a school-wide program, all resources, services, and personnel are blended to make a cohesive program that enhances educational opportunities for ALL students. ### Parent Right To Know

As a parent of a student at a Title 1 served school, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child’s classroom teachers and requires the information to be given to you in a timely manner. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child’s classroom teachers:

- I. Whether the teacher has met the State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction
- II. Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived
- III. Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher
- IV. Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications

Now, type in the teacher’s first and last name. Finally, click on “Search Educator” to view the teacher’s area of certification.
