



COVID Quarantine FAQ

Why is my child quarantined?

The purpose of quarantine is to stop or slow the spread of COVID. We follow the quarantine guidelines that the Ohio Department of Health provided before this school year began. You can read about these by visiting [this link](#)

How long is the quarantine?

Ten calendar days. However, according to the Ohio Department of Health, students who are considered close contacts “can return to normal classroom and extracurricular activities after 7 days if they have received a negative viral (PCR or antigen) test that was performed at least 5 days after exposure.” You can email a negative test result to covidresults@parmacityschools.org.

What happens now?

What happens for school work?

Your child is entitled to make up all assignments that he or she may miss during this time period. These are considered excused absences. Please contact your child’s teacher(s) for more information.

Can I obtain a Chromebook during the time of quarantine?
