**CONDITIONS OF SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY
BY THE PARMA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION**

Having complied with its legal obligations under O.R.C. 3313.41, the Parma City School District Board of Education hereby notifies the public that certain items of personal property (the personal property) will be offered for sale at Byers Field, 7600 Day Drive, Parma, OH, 44134 on April 13, 2024 at 9:00am-2:00pm. The conditions of sale, in accordance with and subject to which all sales shall be made, are as follows:

1. The personal property to be offered for sale is described as follows:

Approximately two hundred desks of various sizes and designs, formerly used by Parma City School District students and teachers that are no longer needed for school purposes.

2. The personal property is located at Byers Field, 7600 Day Drive, Parma, OH, 44134.
3. The personal property is being sold “as-is” without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranty of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose or use, quality, productiveness, or capacity. The Board makes no representation whatsoever regarding the personal property including, without limitation, the propriety of any proposed uses thereof or the continuation of uses thereof former or present, or the characteristics or physical condition thereof will be appropriate for continued use.
4. The personal property will be sold on a “first come-first served” basis at a cost of \$1.00 per item with no further negotiation or discount available. Individual transactions will be considered completed upon purchaser’s payment and receipt of the personal property and ALL SALES ARE FINAL.
5. Purchasers are solely responsible for personally retrieving purchased items and attending the private sale with a vehicle and manpower sufficient to transport purchased items of personal property. District employees are prohibited from assisting purchasers with lifting, moving, removing, organizing, delivering, or storing a purchaser’s personal property.
6. All risk of damage to or loss of the personal property shall be purchasers alone and as an express condition of sale, all purchasers expressly agree to hold harmless and release the Parma City School District Board of Education, and its members, employees, agents, representatives and assigns from all liability relating to participation in the April 13, 2024 sale of personal property, including but not limited

to entering the Board's property and retrieving and transporting items of personal property.

8. Any items of personal property remaining after the April 13, 2024 sale will be disposed of in accordance with applicable Board policy without any further action by the Board of Education.
