

May 17th Senior Update



Final Commencement/Graduation Plans -

We will have a "single family, in-person" ceremony in the PSH auditorium. A Sign Up Genius with time slots will be released online in the coming days (we will send another robo-message/email for when that will be available). All 3 high schools will be released at the same time. We will have 6 Graduate/Family time slots per half hour. This will allow social distancing while also giving each graduate and family time to enjoy their moment. Each graduate will have their name announced, walk the stage, receive their diploma, and have a still shot taken. We will make available the video of the ceremony, edited into one continuous event, as well as photographs released online to download, as soon as we can properly process them. We also communicate further social distancing protocols (masks, gloves, etc) as the event becomes closer. In the interim, we ask that you hold all, or as many as possible, of the dates free. We invite each graduate to bring with them four family members or guests to participate in the ceremony with them. We will present one school administrator, one central office administrator, one member of our School Board, one videographer, and one photographer for a total of ten individuals in the Auditorium at any given time.

Senior Locker Cleanout/Collection of Books/Chromebooks/Yard Signs/Cords &

Collars/Yearbooks - On Tuesday, May 26th we will have Senior Chromebook Turn-In, final locker cleanout, book collection, and yearbook pick-up or purchase for seniors.

1. **Seniors are asked to drop off their Chromebook, charger, and case at Door #50.** It will be a drive-thru process. The DIS Door #50 (garage door) is along the side of the building closest to Parkview elementary, next to the welding room. It is easiest to enter from the back lot, continue to drive past the track, and around to the South side of the building.
2. **Yard signs, Summa/Magna Cords, NHS Collars** will also be handed out by Door #50.

 - b. Pay Student Fees (Credit Card or Bank Checks accepted) Must be paid to receive diploma.

 - e. Seniors are encouraged to stop by the auditorium entrance to meet with our College Now Rep, Mrs. Pollard. She will have Senior Send Off Goodie Bags!

Only required students will need to come in if they have last minute fees to pay, turn in books or equipment or other necessary and required business.
