Student Behavior - Athletic Events and Extracurricular Activities

We had a few instances of inappropriate and/or disrespectful behavior from students attending athletic contests last week. The negative behaviors were primarily with our younger aged students (8th and 9th grades.) Parents, please be aware that attending after school extracurricular events (dances, plays, concerts, athletic events...etc) is a privilege. Students who are not behaving will be asked to leave and will be issued school discipline. We want to keep our extra curricular events positive, please have a conversation with your child regarding this expectation. Thank you!

Student Attendance/Tardies

Students who attend school and their classes regularly have been shown to achieve at higher levels than students who do not have regular attendance and/or large amounts of missed time due to tardiness. Therefore we will place higher expectations on student class time. Please expect to see the administration help our teachers get our students into their classes more. This includes tardy sweeps and individual conversations with frequent students who are missing class time. Please have a conversation with your child about your expectations regarding the importance of being in class.

LOCKER REQUESTS:

Lockers will be assigned by request only. Students that wish to have a locker can make their request in the student service office where they can see Mrs. Haslem or Ms. Flors. Students will then fill out a locker request form and MUST submit their lock combination or a spare key in order to obtain their locker. All lockers are school property and subject to search at any time. This can be done anytime now from 9:00am-2:00pm. Students may also wait until the first week of school to stop by student services to request a locker.

PARKING PERMITS:

This year, we will not require a vehicle inspection, however, in order to obtain a parking permit students must bring payment, a completed parking pass application, driver's license, registration and proof of insurance to our treasurer, Mrs. Kish, anytime between 9:00am and 2:00pm beginning this week.. Please note, there may be no outstanding student fees in order to be issued a parking permit. Student Parking Permits are required at all buildings and will be monitored this year.
