School Attendance Reminder

I want to remind you that the First Period of our school day begins at 7:50am. If students are not in their first period class by that time, they are marked absent or tardy. Over the last month of school, we have seen a considerable increase in the number of students who are late or absent from First period without parental notification. In order to increase accountability, please notify our attendance clerks each day if your child is absent or tardy to school. Beginning in the second semester (January17), if your child is tardy without notification, they may receive disciplinary consequences (detention).
