Midterm exams are starting today and the end of 2nd Quarter is coming to a close.

SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Parma Council of PTAs is pleased to coordinate the Scholarship Program for the graduating seniors of the Parma City School District. This is the largest PTA Council Scholarship Program in the State of Ohio. The 2020-2021 Parma Council of PTAs Scholarship program has over \$80,000 worth of scholarship funds being offered to graduating seniors of the Parma City School District. There are over 50 scholarships to be awarded by Parma Council of PTAs, local PTA and PTSA units, school-affiliated groups, and community organizations. A parent or legal guardian is required to report an absence within 24 hours for a student that is under 18 years old. STUDENTS ENTERING OR LEAVING PVLA:

Students that are changing in or out of PVLA will receive an email from their guidance counselor this week in regards to their new schedule. Please check your emails and reach out to your guidance counselor with any questions!

MIDTERM EXAMS & END OF THE QUARTER:

Midterm exams will be given on January 12, 13, and 14. We will not have a special midterm schedule. Exams will be given during our normal 8 period bell schedule. Teachers will communicate with students the dates of their exams. Students are required to login to class everyday next week (Tues-Thurs).

Friday, January 15th is the end of the marking period. There are no classes for students on this day. This is a teacher inservice day.

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY:

The district requirements for 3rd quarter athletic eligibility will be in place. Please be sure that your child completes and submits any missing assignments prior to the end of the marking period. 2nd Quarter grades determine Winter and the beginning of Spring sports. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

Middle School Grades 7-8

A student must have maintained a 1.0 GPA the preceding marking period.

High School Grades 9-12

A student must have maintained the following GPA the preceding marking period:

After Enrollment into Grade 9

- Grade 9 (First and Second Semesters) - 1.0 GPA
- Grade 10 (Third and Fourth Semesters) - 1.25 GPA
- Grade 11-12 (Fifth through Eighth Semesters) - 1.5 GPA

JANUARY 19th HYBRID SCHEDULE:

Tuesday through Friday when a student is not required to attend school in-person, they are still required to be online from 7:50am-2:30pm when they have classes scheduled. Teachers will communicate to students that are home/offline if they are to log into a Google Meet or complete independent assignments on Google Classroom. Teachers will be posting mini-lessons and assignments for students to view and complete during their regularly scheduled time for class. **Students will be marked AFC (Absent From Class) if assignments are not completed during assigned classes.** It is important for students to maintain a regular school day schedule everyday.

PARMA SCHOOL OF CHOICE:

This is for families who wish for their student to attend a school that is not their student's assigned "home school" building for the next school year (2021-2022). A letter was sent to parents of all students in transition grades (grade 4 & grade 7) to let them know what their assigned school is for next year and how to apply for Parma School of Choice.
