### **8TH GRADE ORIENTATION: Thursday, August 18 - 5:00pm to 7:00pm**

We ask that all parents and guardians please join your child in the auditorium at 6:00 PM for a presentation from the PSH administrative and counseling teams. After the administrative presentation, parents will have the opportunity to walk the building and meet the 8th grade core teachers. ## **LOCKER REQUESTS:**

## **PARKING PERMITS:**

This year, we will not require a vehicle inspection, however, in order to obtain a parking permit students must bring payment, a completed parking pass application, driver's license, registration and proof of insurance to our treasurer, Mrs. Kish, anytime between 9:00am and 2:00pm beginning this week.. Please note, there may be no outstanding student fees in order to be issued a parking permit. Student Parking Permits are required at all buildings and will be monitored this year.
