### State Testing - Begins April 20 and April 21 this week

As you are aware, our Ohio State Testing begins this Thursday, April 20. I have highlighted the tests that students are taking on Thursday and Friday this week.

As I mentioned last week, we will have an adjusted schedule each day of OST testing. Those who are taking tests on Thursday and Friday (all 8th grade ELA and ELA II (10th grade students and others who have been notified by their counselors)) should report to school at the normal time as testing will begin at 7:50am. \*\*If you are unsure if you are testing on these days, please see your counselor.

Students who are not testing do not need to report until your First Period which BEGINS at 9:56 on these days. If you are not testing but at school, you will attend a supervised study hall until testing is over and First Period begins.

3. Make sure to have a Photo ID and your school fees paid. (Photo ID is only needed for the senior buying the tickets)
4. If you want a vegan dish, please request it when purchasing your ticket.
5. Table seating forms will be available when you purchase your ticket. Only one per group/table is needed to ensure you sit with who you want to.
6. If you are taking a guest not from PSH, a guest form is available when you purchase the tickets. The form can be returned to Mrs. Young (RM 126) prior to the day.
7. Formal attire is required.
8. Be prepared to wait in a line the later you buy your tickets.

9. Student guests attending with a PSH senior must be at least a 9th grade student or older.
10. Student guests must adhere to all school rules.
