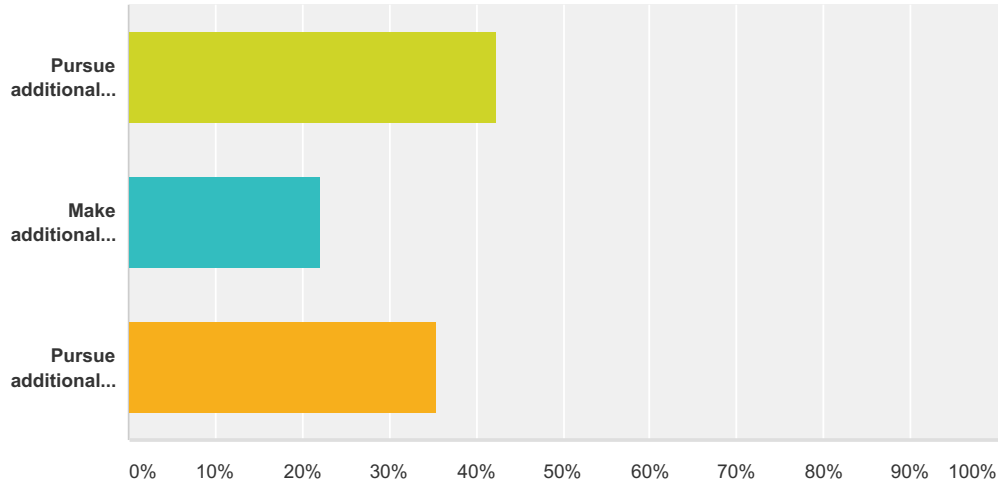


Q1 Would you prefer the District:

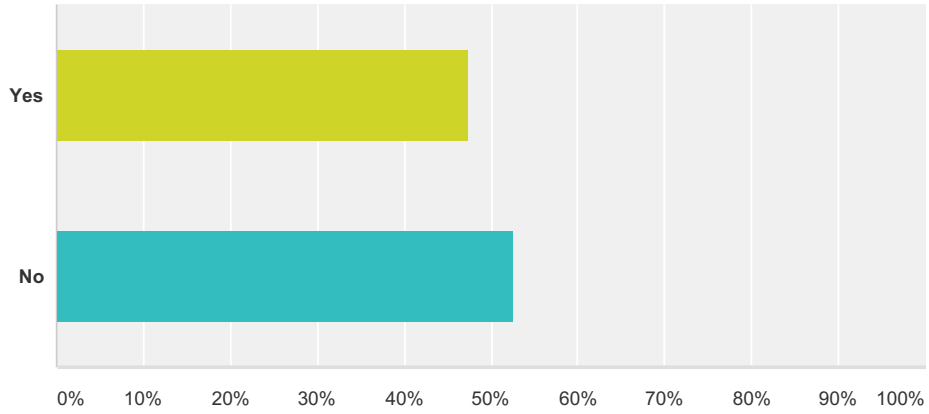

Q2 If you support expenditure reductions, would you support the re-purposing of buildings as a method of achieving these reductions?

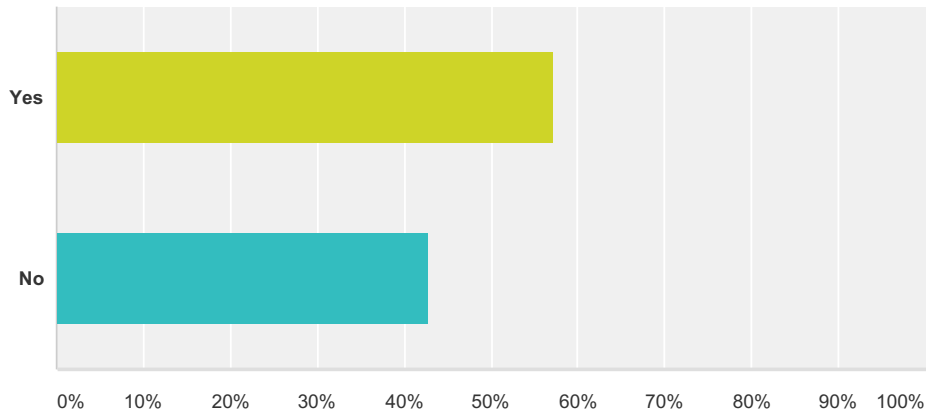

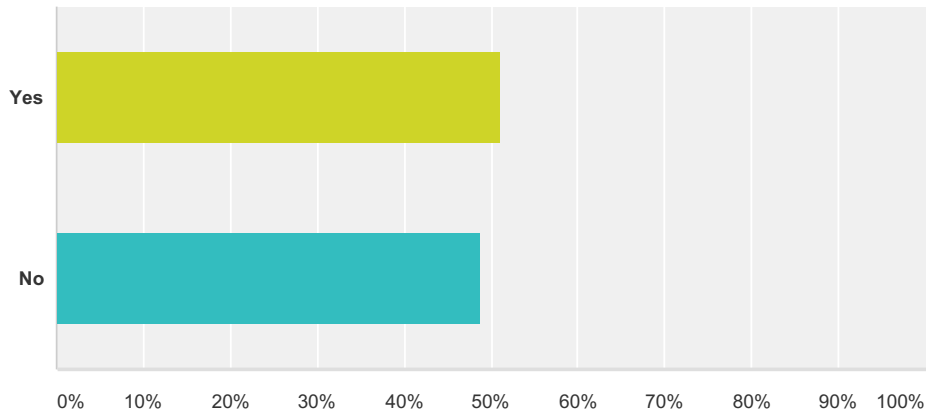

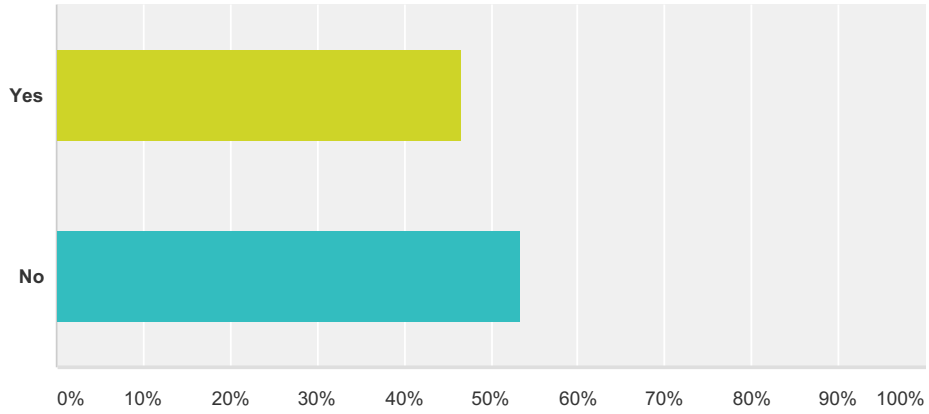

District revenue?**

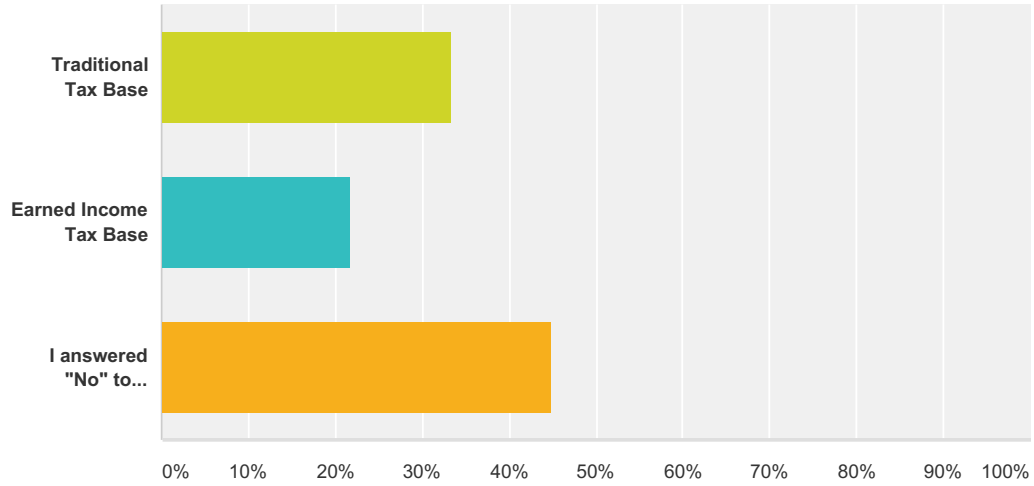
