- Registration updates
  - Process has begun – should have the draft ready for the Board of Education Meeting on December 13<sup>th</sup>
  - One new item is the Credit Recovery Program being offered during the day – mainly for 9<sup>th</sup> grade high fail courses
  - HB 170 – provides the option that students may take a high level computer course instead of Algebra 2, waiting for teacher qualification update, currently states teachers must have Computer Science licensure
