### **Secondary Curriculum – Jeff Cook**

- Registration Guide update
  - Jeff Cook met with the Department Heads in order to gather their input
  - The registration guide for 2019-20 will be ready for the next board meeting on December 13<sup>th</sup>
  - Will also include a summary detailing changes
  - One change is Physical Geology will be a semester class for .5 credit instead of a full year and 1 credit

### **Elementary Curriculum – Michelle Kocar**

- K-5 Curriculum work
  - Will start Social Studies & Science course of study work in January - the state has changed the effective date for state testing requirements from 2019-20 to 2020-21
  - ELA & Math work is still being done
  - Will be looking at ELA materials for next year – Reading Street was continued for this year only
- Gifted updates
  - Megan Kinney has met with all of the principals and cluster teachers to update them on where they stand in regard to the 15 hours of training required by the state
- TGRG updates
  - Approx. 29 students are still retained in third grade
  - Fall test scores have not been received yet – once results are in more students may be promoted to fourth grade
