Secondary Curriculum – Jeff Cook

- ELA- finished common assessments writing including final; had some Edulastic training. Jake Cornish provided small group and one on one instruction to staff. Additional classroom visits were scheduled with Jake.
- CCP numbers will be coming out today for sections of on campus offerings for next year. We have 7 teachers in all three high schools offering possible sections. Updates to be coming.

Elementary Curriculum – Michelle Kocar

- K-5 Curriculum work: May dates for Social Studies and Science align courses of study and curriculum maps to new revised standards- transition year 2019-2020, fully aligned to new standards and state assessments 2020-2021; June work for ELA- to revise curriculum maps/common assessments to new adoption; subs to be paid from federal & general curriculum funding set aside
- Gifted updates: 6 teachers falling slightly short right now on required 15 hours for PD for teachers with served gifted students due to various reasons; Lead GIS working with these staff to ensure required hours/minutes are completed by the last teacher work day so all gifted students in those grade levels/subjects throughout the district are served per our district service model and required state guidelines.
- TGRG updates: Summer school invites will go out this week per DIS (revised) data extract sent late last week.
- Camp Invention: met minimum 70 paid campers so Asst. Director is confirmed; Director will be reviewing instructor applications and setting up interviews.
- ELA Adoption: Reviewed status of adoption, vendor presentation for April 15 and recommendation presentation slated for May 9 BOE meeting; staff have Livebinder of resources including demo log on; public review of materials available in BOE Curriculum Dept. through April 30- will work with PR to publicize.
