**Secondary Curriculum – Jeff Cook**

- Summer School update
  - Dates: June 25 – July 26 (no school July 3, 4, 5)
  - Time: 8:30 – 11:30am
  - Courses are Monday – Friday
  - The program is online and teachers support a flexible schedule for students
    - Students MUST attend class for their assessments
    - Teachers touch base with parents daily
    - With the online program and flexible schedule more credits are being earned by students
  - Currently have apx. 50 students registered for English & Math (some are out of district)

- CTE Perkins update
  - Perkins grant was reauthorized in 2018 by President Trump
  - 2019-20 Transition Year
  - 2020-21 Full implementation
  - State report card will include work based programs for graduation rates
  - If criteria is not met within 3 years - district would be put on a compliance plan
- Summer program update
  - Microsoft internship at CCPL on Snow Road – 11 students participating 25 hours per week
    - All instruction will earn Microsoft credit
  - Coding camps at Greenbriar MS July 8 and July 15 – 9:00am till 3:00pm
  - Program is free per Tech Corp
