Legislation Updates

H.B. 436 Dyslexia Screening and Services ([PCSD Vision Work](#))

- 1. The Committee Develops the Ohio Dyslexia Handbook by December 31, 2021:**
 - a. Includes best practices and methods for universal screening, intervention, and remediation for children with dyslexia or children displaying dyslexic characteristics and tendencies
 - b. Prior to its distribution, the guidebook shall be subject to final approval by the state board of education.
- 2. Other Duties of the Ohio Dyslexia Committee:**
 - a. Determine professional development requirements (6 to 18 hours)
 - b. Maintain a list of courses that fulfill the p.d. requirements (classroom or online)
 - c. Recommend appropriate ratios in school buildings for students to teachers who have received certification in identifying and addressing dyslexia
- 3. Professional Development Requirements**
 - a. Beginning of '23-'24—K and Gr. 1 regular classroom and special ed. teachers
 - b. Beginning of '24-'25—Gr. 2 & 3 regular classroom and special ed. teachers
 - c. Beginning of '25-'26—Gr. 4 through 12 and special ed. teachers
 - d. Any p.d. completed before the required dates and on the list of approved p.d. will count toward the requirement.

S.B. 68 Peace Officer Interaction Curriculum

1. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt a model curriculum for high school students on proper interactions with peace officers during traffic stops and other encounters.
2. Each district shall include this instruction in one or more courses required for graduation

Senate Bill 1 Teaching Financial Literacy in High School

1. Requires one-half unit of instruction in financial literacy for Class of 2025 and beyond
2. Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, a school district or chartered nonpublic school shall require an individual to have an educator license validation in financial literacy to provide financial literacy instruction
