


Our goal at Ridge-Brook Elementary is to teach students about positive behavior in and around our entire school. While lessons may be taught and other reinforcement such as the clip system in each classroom, weather alerts are red slips that can be used by any staff member.

The weather alert is a way to remind students that their behavior follows them all day. Weather alerts are filled out by a staff member who feels that a student needs to “clip down” in his/her homeroom to hold them accountable for poor choices they may have made. These slips are not office referrals to the principal, but enable staff, along with the classroom teacher, to handle discipline as they deem appropriate. This may include contacting a parent at the teacher’s discretion.
