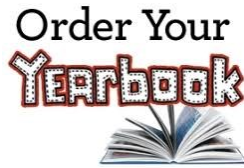

TITLE I NEWS

PARENT TIPS:

Read to your child every day.

Reading aloud to your KINDERGARTNER is the best thing you can do to help build your child's reading skills.

Read everywhere and often.

As your FIRST grader gets better at recognizing words and phrases, provide your child with opportunities to show off his/her skills. Ask your child to read road signs and packages at the grocery store.

Help improve comprehension.

After reading a book with your SECOND grader, ask your child to tell you what the book was about. Being able to remember and restate important details of a story are key to reading comprehension.

Develop comprehension skills.

Ask your THIRD or FOURTH grader what the book was about. Ask if they liked it. Why or why not? Who was your favorite character? Why? What was your favorite part? Why?
