7 Tips to Getting Your Child To Read Over Winter Break:

1. Try a Reading Challenge - Challenge your child to read 20 minutes a day with their favorite book title.
2. Hook Kids with a book set - Go to the library to check out their favorite sets of books, for example, Pete the Cat, Fly Guy, Cam Jansen or Magic Tree House.
3. Share similar titles- Consider read-alike books, for example Julie B. Jones, try Clementine.
4. Find other books in a series that your child already enjoys, for example, Ranger in Time has many books.
5. Read non-fiction, book about planets or weather.
6. Take reading on the road - use audiobooks from the library.
7. Make time to read together as a family.
