Winter Benchmark Testing

The Parma City School District will conduct its mid-year benchmark testing the week of **January 10th**. K-1 will be taking the AIMSweb assessment. Kindergarten students will be assessed on Letter Names, Letter Sounds, Phoneme Segmentation and number identification. 1st Grade students will be assessed on Oral Reading Fluency and math facts. 2-4 will be taking the MAP assessment. This assessment measures students' academic progress in reading and math.
